## A) University Requirements

<b>RCAH 292B or RCAH 292C:</b> Engagement and Reflection (6 credits total) All students will be involved in an engagement project or a set of engagement activities that integrate experiential learning with critical reflection in a manner that is mutually beneficial to the students and community partners.

## C) Elective Pathways — Student must complete **two** of the following courses:

<b>RCAH 310:</b> Topics in Childhood and Society (3 credits)
<b>RCAH 320:</b> Topics in Art and Public Life (3 credits)
<b>RCAH 330:</b> Topics in Nature and Culture (3 credits)
<b>RCAH 340:</b> Topics in Technology and Creativity (3 credits)
In addition to the courses above, students must complete five elective courses totaling 15 to 20 credits taken outside the Residential College in the Arts and Humanities to complete the elective pathway. At least eight of the credits must be at the 300-level or above. These courses will be chosen in consultation with the student’s academic advisor.

## D) Language Proficiency Requirement
